- A. *Political culture* commonly shared attitudes, beliefs and core values about how government should operate
- B. FIVE important elements of pol. cult.
 - 1. Liberty preoccupation w/ rights
 - 2. Equality equal vote, equal opportunity, but not equal wealth
 - 3. *Democracy* politicians accountable to the people
 - 4. Civic Duty serve community
 - 5. *Individual Responsibility* barring disability, individuals are responsible for own actions and well being

- A. *Political socialization* process by which parents and others teach children about values, beliefs and attitudes of political culture
- B. Agents of Socialization or Influencing Factors
